We therefore invite you to submit proposals for texts concerning the creation of information, methods of its presentation and transmission in various media and formats, with the participation of multiple entities (individuals, groups, institutions), as well as issues of information literacy and information behavior.

We also accept submissions not directly related to the proposed topic, but remaining within the research area of library and information science, and the broader context of communication and media studies.
